

Stages of Provisional Admission For Applicants from the British Secondary School System

and International Baccalaureate (IB) System



Provisional admission represents a conditional acceptance that depends on the predicted, non-final grades acquired by students applying to Qatar University. Typically applicable to graduates of international high schools following the English curriculum, this type of admission is offered due to the final, official results of such curriculum being released after the announcement of admission decisions. In order for the provisional admission to become final, students must achieve actual grades that are equal to or higher than their predicted grades and submit the official documents confirming this.



First Stage **Application Phase**

Students submit an electronic admission application during the announced application period for each academic semester.

Students submit the required documents during the announced submission period for each academic semester **Required Documents:**

- Original certificates for the completed subjects.
- For subjects that are currently being studied, predicted grades must be reported and certified by students' school using Qatar University's Predicted Grades Form.

Second Stage

Post-Acceptance Phase (Provisional Acceptance)

Upon provisional acceptance based on predicted grades, students receive a special acceptance letter detailing the nature and terms of their acceptance and the final deadline for submitting their electronic results.

To proceed with university course registration, students must sign a supplement acknowledging their provisional acceptance and their obligation to submit their electronic results, within the agreed timeline.

Students must submit electronic results according to the specified deadlines in order to ensure a thorough evaluation of their acceptance status.

Provisionally admitted students will be contacted to inform them of the evaluation outcome for the electronic results. If their decision is affected, it will be implemented and applied to their acceptance decision.



Note: Failure to submit electronic results within the deadline will result in students' admission being canceled.



Third and final Stage (Final Results Submission)

Unless students submit their final, original certificates and the evaluation process is completed, students' record will be restricted, disabling them from registering for the subsequent semester.

Students must submit their final, original certificates, as electronic results cannot be considered at this stage.

Students will be informed of their final evaluation outcomes, and if students' decision is affected, it will be implemented on their admission application.

Note: Failure to submit the final, original certificates within the deadline will result in the cancellation of students' admission.



Remember



Check your university email account regularly and pay attention to any messages sent by the Admission Department.

Do not hesitate to contact the Admissions Department to evaluate your results or to verify that you meet the admission requirements.

Remember that your admission is provisional and will only be finalized upon the submission of your final results.

Failure to meet the deadlines for provisional admission may result in the cancellation of your admission.
