

Training Course	Arabic for Non- Native Speakers – course 3
Course Language	English & Arabic
Course Duration	36 hours.

Course Objectives	<p>By the end of this course participator will, have reached Beginner –High to Intermediate-Low proficiency in Arabic (according to ACTFL guidelines) which means that s/he will be able to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1- Speak about himself /herself and his/her environment, initiate 2- Sustain conversations on a number of topics (e.g., family, friends, study, etc.,) and narrate in present, past and future time frames. 3- Read texts on familiar topics and understand the main ideas without using the dictionary Writing essential sentences about daily life. 4- Comprehend simple Arabic discourse dealing with familiar topics, 5- Carry out written transactions connected to daily life and write short letters and essays, 6- Be familiar with many aspects of Arab culture, such as social and religious customs and traditions, family life, and education, 7- Recognize and use verbs in all major tenses, recognize and form complex sentence structures such as dependent clauses, and recognize and use negation patterns
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Course Key Topic Area Includes:

Course Content

- 1- Simple short conversation and exchanges with around 1500 words and expression in daily life situations and news.
- 2- Reading simple short texts and news material.
- 3- Acting scenarios, and create them.
- 4- Listening to simple short conversations.
- 5- Some culture aspects

There will be no grammar explanations given during class time. We expect the learner to experiment grammar by actively reading, memorizing material in charts and preparing drills assigned.
